### City of Melfort - ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT

Public Notice is hereby given that at their July 14th, 2008, regular meeting, the City of Melfort Council, pursuant to Section 207 of *The Planning & Development Act, 2007*, will consider a Bylaw to amend the Melfort Zoning Bylaw No. 96-09, as hereinafter provided:

#### Intent:

It is proposed to amend the Zoning District Map forming part of Zoning Bylaw No. 96-09, in the manner hereinafter set forth:

- (a) by rezoning from C3 – Shopping Centre Commercial to R3 – Multiple Unit Residential, Parcel J, Plan 79PA15796, Extension 1;  
(b) by rezoning from C3 – Shopping Centre Commercial to R3 – Multiple Unit Residential, Parcel K, Plan 80PA15178, Extension 4, and Parcel L, Plan 80PA15178, Extension 2;  
(c) by rezoning from R2 – Medium Density Residential to R4 – Mobile Home Residential, Lots 1 and 3, Block T, Plan 77PA09097, Extension 0.
- This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of its final passing thereof.

The proposed Bylaw and attached Schedules may be inspected by any interested person at the City Office of the City of Melfort, 202 Burrows Avenue West, Melfort, Saskatchewan, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The Council of the City of Melfort will hear all submissions regarding the proposed amendments and all persons who are present and wish to speak at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, July 14th, 2008. All written submissions received by 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 10th, 2008, will be forwarded to Council.
