**City of Melfort - ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT**

Public Notice is hereby given that at their July 14th, 2008, regular meeting, the City of Melfort Council, pursuant to Section 207 of *The Planning & Development Act, 2007*, will consider a Bylaw to amend the Melfort Zoning Bylaw No. 96-09, as hereinafter provided:

**Intent:**

It is proposed to amend the Zoning District Map forming part of Zoning Bylaw No. 96-09, in the manner hereinafter set forth:

1. (a) by rezoning from C3 – Shopping Centre Commercial to R3 – Multiple Unit Residential, Parcel J, Plan 79PA15796, Extension 1;
- (b) by rezoning from C3 – Shopping Centre Commercial to R3 – Multiple Unit Residential, Parcel K, Plan 80PA15178, Extension 4, and Parcel L, Plan 80PA15178, Extension 2;
- (c) by rezoning from R2 – Medium Density Residential to R4 – Mobile Home Residential, Lots 1 and 3, Block T, Plan 77PA09097, Extension 0.

2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of its final passing thereof.

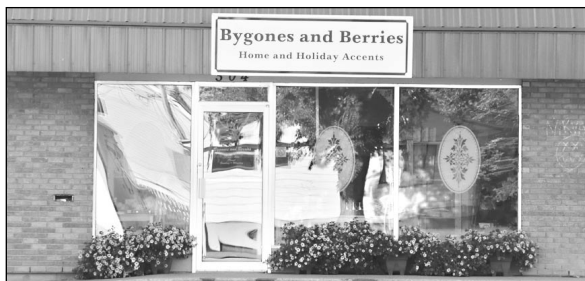
