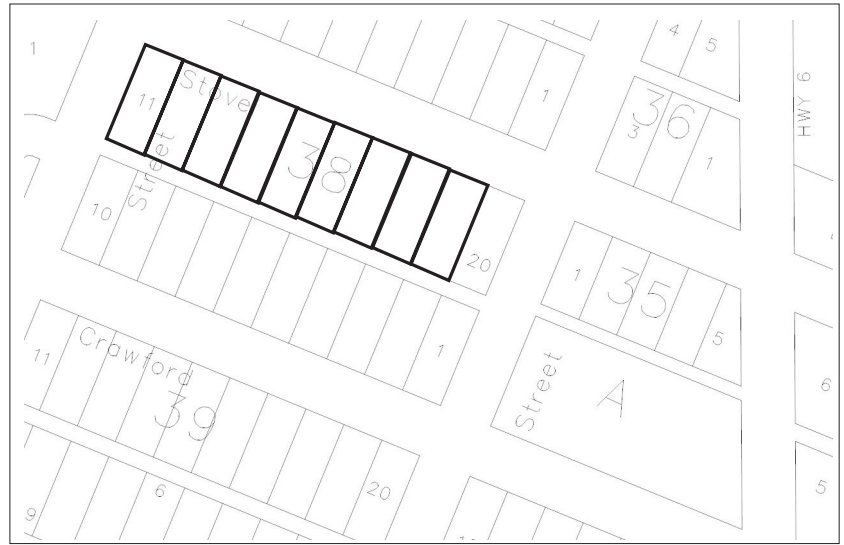

Name the Neighbourhood

Under the guidance of the Community Growth Committee the City of Melfort is accepting submissions for the *Name the Neighbourhood contest*. Citizens are invited to pick up a map and form from Melfort City Hall and enter an appropriate name for one or all of the seven designated neighbourhoods. Submissions will be accepted at Melfort City Hall (Box 2230) until August 29th. People may also obtain forms from the City of Melfort website at www.cityofmelfort.ca. Only entries with the submitter's name and phone number will be accepted. Any questions may be directed to Ken Ottenbreit at 752-5911.

The City of Melfort is accepting proposals to purchase from 1 to 9 lots which are available on the 500 Block of Stovel Avenue West. Proposals must include the proposed use of the lots and the exact lots the party is interested in. The lots are zoned R2 - Medium Density Residential and services include water, sewer, gas, power, curb, pavement (as is) and street lights. The purchaser will be responsible for water and sewer hook-ups to the property line and any consolidation and legal costs. The minimum accepted bid per lot is \$29,000. The deadline to accept proposals is August 1st at 4:30 p.m.
