## NORTHERN LIGHTS PALACE POOL FALL LEADERSHIP COURSES

### LSS Standard First Aid – Dec. 5, 6, 7 – \$150

Teaches the care of injuries and illnesses, including how to treat pulseless victims and basic life support skills. Emphasis is placed on vital signs, priority assessment and basic emergency care principles. Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Training included. This course includes First Aid & CPR Guidelines 2005 and meets OH&S regulations for Basic First Aid.

### Bronze Medallion – Dec. 12, 13, 14 - \$ 85 plus books

The Bronze Medallion award teaches an understanding of the life-saving principles embodied in the four components of water rescue education: judgment, knowledge, skill and fitness.

Rescuers learn tows and carries and defence and release methods in preparation for challenging rescues of increased risk, involving conscious and unconscious victims of various types. Participants also develop stroke efficiency and endurance in timed swims, as well as treatment skills for many circulatory emergencies.

*With the change of seasons and the recent snowfall people's attentions focus on winter activities. The City of Melfort encourages people to have an active, healthy, and safe winter. For snow enthusiasts we advise everyone to abide by the following provisions concerning snowmobile operations.*

### **Snowmobiles**

- No person shall operate a snowmobile within the City limits, except for the sole purpose of directly leaving and/or returning to the City between the hours of 7:00 am and 11:00 pm.
- Snowmobile operators must be 16 years of age or older with a valid driver's license, who have completed a safety course if applicable.
- Every snowmobile in operation has to be registered.
- Snowmobiles are to be operated in single file as far to the right hand side of the road as practicable and not in excess of 30 kph
