The Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPPS) allows you to make monthly property tax payments that are automatically deducted from your bank account at the end of each month. If you find it difficult to make a single large payment when your property taxes come due, you may want to consider this payment option. Conveniences you'll enjoy: no more cheques or postage, easier monthly budgeting, no line-ups or last minute rush.

A 2% discount will be offered on the prepayment of taxes from January 1, 2009 to January 31, 2009. Actual levies will not be set until May 2009, but you can prepay all or a portion of your taxes, based on your 2008 tax bill and receive a discount.

Parking

NO PERSON SHALL PARK ANY VEHICLE:

- in Handicapped Parking Spaces other than a vehicle designed for a physically disabled person including passenger vehicles displaying a special license plate or other material to identify the vehicle. PLEASE MAKE SURE THE SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION IS VERY VISIBLE. Please DO NOT PARK in the Handicapped Parking Space when you don't have a health condition that warrants the need to do so.
- on any street or avenue in the City for an uninterrupted period of time longer than 48 hours – doing so may cause the vehicle to be hauled away at the expense of the owner.
- within 3.05 metres (10') of a fire hydrant measured parallel to the curb.
- with any portion of vehicle extending over the sidewalk or sidewalk crossing.
- with its **left side to the curb**.
- in a manner that is not wholly within one parking stall, in any area of designed parking stalls.
