**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO  
CONSTRUCT CERTAIN  
LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS**

**TAKE NOTICE THAT:**

1. The Council of the City of Melfort intends to construct paving/repair on the following streets:

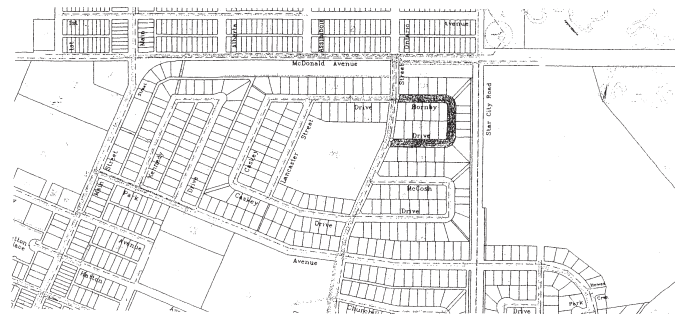
Street	From	To
Hornby Drive	Brunswick Street	Brunswick Street

as a local improvement, and intends to specially assess a part of the cost upon the land abutting directly on the work.

2. Property owners will be billed and may pay the full amount of \$192.50 per front metre with no interest by December 31st of the year the project is complete.

3. The estimated cost of the work is \$213,800.00 of which \$81,288.78 is to be paid by the City. If the cost referred to in Section 2 of this notice is not paid, the annual rate per metre frontage, including an interest rate of 7% is \$35.72. The special assessment is to be paid in **seven consecutive annual installments**, commencing in the year following completion of the project.

4. Owners of lots abutting directly on the work desiring to petition against undertaking the work must do so on or before 10:00 a.m. on the 25th day of March, 2009. To be successful the petition must be signed by a majority in number of owners of lands to specially assessed for the proposed local improvement, representing at least one-half of the assessed value in the most recent assessment roll of these lands. Advice on preparing the petition to ensure its validity is available from the municipal clerk/administrator.

**NOTICE TO ALL PET OWNERS  
REMINDER ANNUAL LICENSE FEES MUST

- ❖ IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CAT BYLAW NO. 2007-24 AND DOG BYLAW NO. 03-05 ALL PET OWNERS ARE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE A LICENSE FOR THEIR PET ANNUALLY.
- ❖ LICENSE FEES ARE \$10 IF THE CAT/DOG IS SPAYED OR NEUTERED OTHERWISE FEE IS \$30. FEES ARE TO BE PAID AT CITY HALL.
- ❖ THEY MUST WEAR A COLLAR DISPLAYING A VALID LICENSE TAG. CATS MAY BE TATTOOED OR IMPLANTED WITH AN IDENTIFICATION MICROCHIP; HOWEVER A LICENSE MUST STILL BE PURCHASED.
- ❖ OWNERS ARE TO ENSURE THAT THEIR CAT/DOG IS NOT RUNNING AT LARGE OR BEING A NUISANCE ON ANY OTHER PROPERTY.
- ❖ ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED WHEN OFF OF OWNER'S PROPERTY.
- ❖ FAILURE TO PAY COULD RESULT IN THE OWNER PAYING A PENALTY.
