ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT

Public Notice is hereby given that at their January 11, 2010, regular meeting, the City of Melfort Council, pursuant to Section 207 of The Planning & Development Act, 2007, will consider a Bylaw to amend the Melfort Zoning Bylaw No. 96-09, as hereinafter provided:

Intent:



It is proposed to amend Zoning Bylaw No. 96-09, in the manner hereinafter set forth:

That subsection 10.3.4 Regulations for R1A - Low Density Residential District be amended to increase the minimum floor area requirement from 93 square metres (1,001.08 sq. ft.) to 112 square metres (1,205 sq. ft.).

The proposed Bylaw and attached Schedules may be inspected by any interested person at the City Office of the City of Melfort, 202 Burrows Avenue West, Melfort, Saskatchewan, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The Council of the City of Melfort will hear all submissions regarding the proposed amendments and all persons who are present and wish to speak at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, January 11, 2010. All written submissions received by 12:00 noon on Thursday, January 7, 2010, will be forwarded to Council.

NOTICE TO ALL PET OWNERS
REMINDER ANNUAL LICENSE FEES MUST BE PAID NOW

- ❖ IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CAT BYLAW NO. 2007-24 AND DOG BYLAW NO. 03-05 - ALL PET OWNERS ARE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE A LICENSE FOR THEIR PET ANNUALLY.
- ❖ LICENSE FEES ARE \$10 IF THE CAT/DOG IS SPAYED OR NEUTERED OTHERWISE FEE IS \$30. FEES ARE TO BE PAID AT CITY HALL.
- ❖ THEY MUST WEAR A COLLAR DISPLAYING A VALID LICENSE TAG. CATS MAY BE TATTOOED OR IMPLANTED WITH AN IDENTIFICATION MICROCHIP; HOWEVER A LICENSE MUST STILL BE PURCHASED.
- ❖ OWNERS ARE TO ENSURE THAT THEIR CAT/DOG IS NOT RUNNING AT LARGE OR BEING A NUISANCE ON ANY OTHER PROPERTY.
- ❖ FAILURE TO PAY COULD RESULT IN THE OWNER PAYING A PENALTY.
