### **NOTICE TO ALL PET OWNERS**

#### **REMINDER ANNUAL LICENSE FEES MUST BE PAID NOW**

- IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CAT BYLAW NO. 2007-24 AND DOG BYLAW NO. 03-05 ALL PET OWNERS ARE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE A LICENSE FOR THEIR PET ANNUALLY.
- LICENSE FEES ARE \$10 IF THE CAT/DOG IS SPAYED OR NEUTERED OTHERWISE FEE IS \$30. FEES ARE TO BE PAID AT CITY HALL.
- THEY MUST WEAR A COLLAR DISPLAYING A VALID LICENSE TAG. CATS MAY BE TATTOOED OR IMPLANTED WITH AN IDENTIFICATION MICROCHIP; HOWEVER A LICENSE MUST STILL BE PURCHASED.
- OWNERS ARE TO ENSURE THAT THEIR CAT/DOG IS NOT RUNNING AT LARGE OR BEING A NUISANCE ON ANY OTHER PROPERTY.
- FAILURE TO PAY COULD RESULT IN THE OWNER PAYING A PENALTY.

### **Parking**

#### **NO PERSON SHALL PARK ANY VEHICLE:**

- in **Handicapped Parking Spaces** other than a vehicle designed for a physically disabled person including passenger vehicles displaying a special license plate or other material to identify the vehicle. PLEASE MAKE SURE THE SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION IS VERY VISIBLE. Please DO NOT PARK in the Handicapped Parking Space when you don't have a health condition that warrants the need to do so.
- on any street or avenue in the City for an uninterrupted period of time longer than **48 hours** – doing so may cause the vehicle to be hauled away at the expense of the owner.
- within 3.05 metres (10') of a fire hydrant measured parallel to the curb.
- with any portion of vehicle extending over the sidewalk or sidewalk crossing.
- with its **left side to the curb**.
- in a manner that is not wholly within one parking stall, in any area of designed parking stalls.

### **Snow Removal**

When the snow falls, you become the owner of whatever snow falls on your property.

- No one is to shovel or deposit snow, ice or dirt onto any City street or lane from their private property.
- When cleaning your driveways, the snow is to be deposited onto the owner's own property, not the City's or that of the neighbors.
- Businesses are to keep the sidewalks adjacent to their place of business clear and free from snow. Failure to do so will cause the removal of the snow and the expense of that removal to become that of the occupant or owner of the business.
