NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

LANDFILL FEE INCREASE

The minimum charge at the Landfill for residents of Melfort will increase from \$5.00 to \$6.00 for the first 100kg (220lbs) of waste. Non resident fees will increase from \$7.00 to \$9.00 and from \$30.00/1000kgs (2200) lbs over 100kg to \$40.00/1000kgs. The new rates are effective **May 1st, 2010.**

Northern Lights Palace Pool Leadership Courses

NLS Recert – May 15
 Standard First Aid Recert – May 15

LSS Standard First Aid / AEC – May 21, 22, 23
 Teaches the care of injuries and illnesses, including how to treat pulseless victims and basic life support skills. Emphasis is placed on vital signs, priority assessment and basic emergency care principles. Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Training Included. This course includes First Aid & CPR Guidelines 2005 and meets OH&S regulations for Basic First Aid. Extra AEC component not required for those needing SFA, but is required for those wishing to become lifeguards. \$150

National Lifeguard Service (NLS) – May 29, 30, 31, June 4, 5, 6
 Recognized as the standard measure of lifeguard performance in Canada, NLS education is designed to develop a sound understanding of lifeguarding principles, good judgment, and a mature and responsible attitude toward the role of the lifeguard.

The primary role of the NLS lifeguard is the prevention of emergency situations and, where this fails, the timely and effective resolution of emergencies. The NLS award is designed to prepare lifeguards to fulfill this role as professional facilitators of safe, enjoyable aquatics.

* must be 16yrs and held the Bronze Cross award with a current Standard First Aid Certificate. \$221 plus books & whistle (Alert \$32)

This is a required course for lifeguards at the NLP Pool.

The Department will pick up all garbage, such as tree limbs, leaves, grass and garden refuse. All tree limbs must be under 4' in length, branches must be tied in bundles and leaves and grass must be in a waste container or bagged in a leaf & garden (see through) clear bag.
