NOTICE City of Melfort ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT

Public Notice is hereby given that at their August 3, 2010, special meeting, the City of Melfort Council, pursuant to Section 207 of The Planning & Development Act, 2007, will consider a Bylaw to amend the Melfort Zoning Bylaw No. 96-09, as hereinafter provided:

Intent:

It is proposed to amend Zoning Bylaw No. 96-09, in the manner hereinafter set forth:

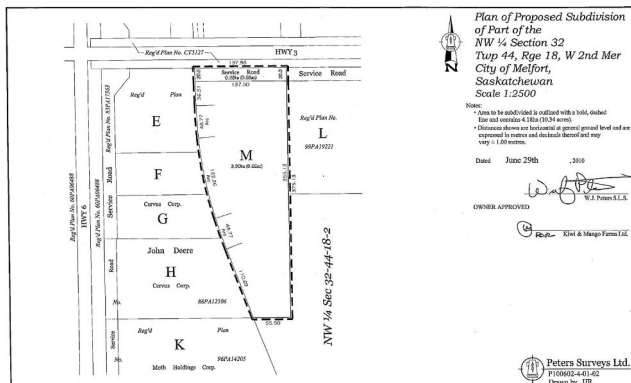
- Subsection 10.4.4 (3) – Multiple Unit Dwellings, is amended by deleting “Yard, side – minimum” requirements and replacing it with the following: “Yard, side – minimum – 1.5 metres (4.92 ft.) or half the average wall height whichever is greater, except that the side yard may be reduced by Council for buildings that were constructed prior to 1960 to accommodate the redevelopment of existing sites, but not less than 0.5 metres (1.64 ft.)”
- The Zoning District Map referred to in Section 9.2 is amended by rezoning from UH - Urban Holding to C2 - Highway Commercial all the land shown within the bold dashed line on the plan of proposed subdivision below dated June 29, 2010, and signed by W. J. Peters, S.L.S., which forms part of the bylaw.

The proposed Bylaw may be inspected by any interested person at the City Office of the City of Melfort, 202 Burrows Avenue West, Melfort, Saskatchewan, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The Council of the City of Melfort will hear all submissions regarding the proposed amendments and all persons who are present and wish to speak at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 3, 2010. All written submissions received by 12:00 noon on Thursday, July 29, 2010, will be forwarded to Council.
